LETTER FROM THE FOUNDATION BOARD

Among Clearwater Camp's many traditions is the celebration and homecoming each group of voyageurs enjoys upon their return from a camping trip. As their vehicle honks through camp, the trippers are swarmed by well-wishers. In return, around the next campfire, the trippers amuse their fellow campers by recounting their journey's shared challenges, achievements and lessons learned. Most importantly, the voyageurs know that —while the celebration is much deserved—their latest accomplishment only readies them for the next journey ahead.

It's a fitting vignette for Clearwater Camp as we celebrate our 75th Anniversary, our Diamond Jubilee Summer. What a community celebration and homecoming we have all earned! With the continued hard work, devotion and generosity of our voyageur circle, Clearwater Camp has successfully entered a new phase of its history along Tomahawk Lake: We are now one of the premier non-profit camps in the country. To achieve that status, the Clearwater Camp Foundation accomplished its primary goal of purchasing Clearwater Camp from six shareholders. We did that together, after raising a total of \$2.7 million in cash and \$1.1 million in pledges. That combined with a \$1.3 million mortgage loan enabled the Foundation to secure the property in early 2008 so that Clearwater Camp will indeed span the generations.

But beyond the miles we've traveled in the last year are the "trip sparks" themselves, the many stories about teamwork and individual efforts that continue to inspire and drive

us forward. Early in 2007, a three-generation camp family stepped forward with a \$1 Million Leadership Challenge for the rest of us, a pledge to match every new donation dollar-for-dollar up to a total gift of one million dollars. With that call to stewardship, many of you responded. You gave what you could, and as a result, in 2007 we doubled our number of campaign donors and raised an impressive \$1.6 million in cash and more than \$250,000 in pledges.

Yet, as we celebrate our accomplishments during this last year, we must ready ourselves for the journey ahead. We need to invite more of our fellow alumnae, families, neighbors and supporters to join our Voyageur Campaign. Our ongoing campaign has three phases: phase one was completed with the purchase of the camp, the second stage is to retire our \$1.3 million mortgage loan, and the final challenge is to complete our Voyageur Campaign goal of
